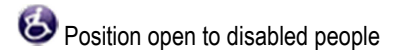

PRESENTATION OF THE AGENCY

Santé publique France is the French National Public Health Agency. It operates for the Ministry of Health and was created by Ordinance 2016-246 of 15 April 2016. Its field of intervention is population health. As a scientific agency providing expertise in public health, its missions include:

- 1 ° Epidemiological monitoring and surveillance of the health status of populations;
- 2 ° Monitoring of health threats;
- 3 ° Health promotion and reduction of health risks;
- 4 ° Development of prevention and health education;
- 5 ° Preparedness and responses to counter health threats or crises;
- 6 ° Early warning and alerts.

The agency includes 10 scientific and transversal divisions and 6 support divisions. Its work program, adopted by its Management Board, is based on five priority axes: health determinants, populations, pathologies, interventions and territories, and infrastructures.

PRESENTATION OF THE DIVISION AND UNIT

Infectious Diseases Division - Respiratory Infections and Immunization Unit

The Infectious Diseases Division (DMI) of Santé publique France coordinates national surveillance of infectious diseases, early warning and response activities in this field. It carries out or participates in descriptive or analytical epidemiological studies, risk analysis projects or modelling of the dynamics of the transmission of infectious diseases.

The Respiratory Infections and Immunization Unit (REV) counts 15 persons, including 12 epidemiologists. It conducts surveillance activities for respiratory infections and vaccine-preventable diseases. The unit is in charge of evaluating the impact of immunization programs. The evaluation of vaccination effectiveness and coverage is also part of its mission. It also conducts a priori analyses for new vaccines in order to estimate the impact of their introduction on the immunization schedule. This work is carried out in close collaboration with the National Immunization Technical Advisory Group (CTV). Those activities are complemented by the investigation of clusters/outbreaks. The unit is also in charge of partially- or non-vaccine diseases: severe bacterial infections, maternal infections leading to foetopathies, and respiratory infections including legionellosis and tuberculosis.

DESCRIPTION OF THE POSITION

Missions	<p>This position is oriented towards respiratory infections and vaccination expertise. Under the responsibility of the unit head, the position holder will be the resource epidemiologist for pneumococcal and respiratory syncytial virus infections and will contribute to the agency's work in the area of immunization. He will carry out the following activities:</p>
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Epidemiological surveillance:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Development, implementation, facilitation and coordination of surveillance systems;- Exploitation and valorisation of surveillance data, including data from hospital and health-insurance records ;- Evaluation of surveillance systems.- Studies for defining or evaluating control strategies;- Contribution to a priori / a posteriori evaluation of the impact of vaccination strategies;- Support to the regional offices of the agency (Cires) for the investigation of clusters/outbreaks/unusual events and expertise provided to Regional Health Authorities (ARS) for the implementation of the prevention and control measures;- Participation to expert working groups of the Ministry of Health, the High Council of Public Health, the High Authority of Health or other agencies regarding control strategies;- Supervision of data managers, residents or Master students;- Training activities;- Participation in European projects;- Scientific monitoring of the literature in its field of expertise. <p>He will provide support, as appropriate, for these same activities for other diseases for which the REV unit is in charge. He will participate in the agency's on-call duties (nights or week-ends) and will contribute to any action entering the missions of the agency if this proves necessary in a crisis situation, within the limits of his competences.</p>
