What are the signs of Mpox?





Skin lesions often occurring on the body



Swollen lymph nodes in the neck or groin





Fever



Muscle aches

How do you get Mpox?



Contact with monkeypox skin lesions or scabs





Sharing linens, personal hygiene items, eating utensils



What if I am not sure?



Consult a doctor or go to a CeGIDD (centre for free information, screening and diagnosis)




Isolate for 3 weeks if monkeypox is confirmed



Protect others, wash your hands and keep skin lesions covered

How can I protect myself?



Avoid physical contact, including sex, with an infected person



Do not share your things with an infected person (linens, personal hygiene items, eating utensils)



Mpox vaccine for those considered at high risk of infection
